COMMUNITY PATIO - A 1700 square foot brick Patio that includes a moveable bar, electric hook ups for bands, ADA accessible ramp, door to access the Neighbors Room, and storage for equipment and patio furniture.



FRONT WALKWAY - A historically reconstructed front brick walkway with authentic landscaping, first designed by famed landscape architect Jens Jensen.



FOUNDATION - A reconstructing of the foundation wall on the west side of the building, which will ensure that our community will be able to enjoy the Assembly Hall for generations to come.
