

## Updated Mask Guidelines For the Kenilworth Park District 8.23.2021

On Friday, August 20, 2021 the Cook County Department of Public Health issued an update for COVID-19 safety practices. The following are a list of those updates and how they will be enacted at the Kenilworth Park District:

- Effective Monday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>, any individual aged two and older will be required to wear a mask when indoors in a public space, regardless of vaccination status.
- Common public spaces include but are not limited to retail stores, health and fitness clubs, hotels, performance venues, movie theaters, commercial buildings, public transportation, and restaurants and bars when patrons are not actively eating/drinking.
- All events held indoors at the Kenilworth Assembly Hall will require patrons to wear masks, regardless of vaccination status.
- All programs run by the Kenilworth Park District indoors will require participants and staff to wear masks, regardless of vaccination status.
