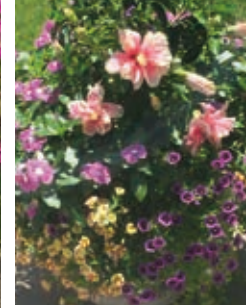

director's letter

DEAR RESIDENTS OF KENILWORTH

A year ago, the Kenilworth Park District was entrusted with the responsibility of the Kenilworth Assembly Hall with a goal of returning it to the community center it was intended when it was built in 1907. We are thrilled to report that we have made great strides in achieving this goal.

As new stewards of the building, we immediately took action and reached out to fire and health departments as well as structural and civil engineers to ensure that all systems met current safety standards and building codes. With their input, we got to work on needed infrastructure and general maintenance concerns including the replacement of old knob and tube wiring, foundation repair and new interior drain tile to reduce basement flooding. Historical paint experts helped select paint colors that met historical requirements, providing a much-needed facelift and helped to lighten the interior of the building. More efficient lighting was introduced in the building with installation of LEF bulbs, leading to a 40% reduction in electrical consumption. We also cleaned up the grounds, and trimmed trees and bushes to make the outside appearance more inviting.

To enhance the facility and programming we purchased new microphones, audio systems, banquet chairs, and replaced the aging stage curtains. Additionally, a 180-inch ultra-high definition projector screen was installed to facilitate rentals and community programming such as family movie nights and football viewing parties. We

recently refinished the beautiful floors with a commercial seal, providing lasting protection from the elements for years to come.

We just finished converting the old kitchen space into the main Park District office so that we can better serve the needs of residents. The new office allows our staff to be accessible from 8:30AM - 5:00PM, Monday-Friday. Staff members are ready to field questions, accept registrations, create new programming, and conduct tours of the beautiful and historic George Maher inspired building. Since obtaining ownership, the Park District has invested an estimated \$180,000 in building repairs and improvements. There is still much more work to be done to ensure that this 110-year-old building remains the historic treasure it is, and a 501c3 fund has been established to allow for community gifts and donations to ensure we are able to meet these needs. Please contact us if you are interested in contributing.

Along with structural repairs and facility upgrades, we have been hard at work providing a variety of programming options to the community. With the unique features of the Kenilworth Assembly Hall, the Park District is now able to offer more programming and enrichment opportunities for residents. This past summer we experienced a constant flurry of activity: children coming in and out for camps, classes, and birthday parties, while adults meet with neighbors for social gatherings and events. We have added

dozens of children's programs such as theater, sports development, chess, rock and roll preschool, kids cooking, and more. For adults, we have included floral design classes, square dancing lessons, keynote speakers, tasting events, holiday events and more. We have become members of the Wilmette/Kenilworth Chamber of Commerce, partnering with them on grand-scale events such as the Taste of Wilmette/Kenilworth, thus enhancing our visibility to the local communities.

Our main source of revenue no longer comes from non-resident weddings, but from programming fees, rentals for school fundraisers and benefits, and private neighborhood parties, to list a few examples. In fact, we are proud to report that the park district has earned four-times the amount of wedding rental income, from resident-facilitated rentals and programming. Further, tenant organizations such as the Neighbors of Kenilworth, Kenilworth Garden Clubs, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts and others have returned and are renting the facility for their regular meeting use.

Management of the Assembly Hall has allowed us a year of tremendous growth and we feel that we are just getting started. Recently, we joined forces with marketing professionals who are improving our online presence and therefore access for our residents. We have launched www.kenilworthassemblyhall.org and www.kpdcamps.org which have improved our online presence. The Kenilworth Park District also has an email distribu-

tion list which we use to share information regarding upcoming programming and events. We encourage all Kenilworth residents to sign up for our email list. It is very easy to do. You can come to Assembly Hall, send us an email at info@kenilworth-parkdistrict.org or from your cell phone, text the word KPDIS-TRICT to 22828. You will be prompted with a message that will ask you to respond with your email address. Once you reply with your email address, you are registered!

With the spring approaching, we have added dozens of new classes for children and adults. This is especially true for our summer camps, where we have added several programs and camps to fill the days of children with working parents. We want to thank the residents of Kenilworth for supporting us through participating in our programs or renting the Kenilworth Assembly Hall for your events. We look forward to continuing to grow as a Park District and as a pillar of this fantastic community. Please stop by to visit us, see the improvements we have made to the Assembly Hall, sign up for a program, or reserve the building for an upcoming event!

Obtaining a liquor license allows not only for a wider variety of unique events offered, but will also help raise funds for maintaining our beautiful space. *Don't forget, you can always make a donation to the Friends of Kenilworth.* This 501c3 organization assists in funding improvement projects and maintenance of the Kenilworth Assembly Hall where we delight in seeing people and organizations hosting their events.

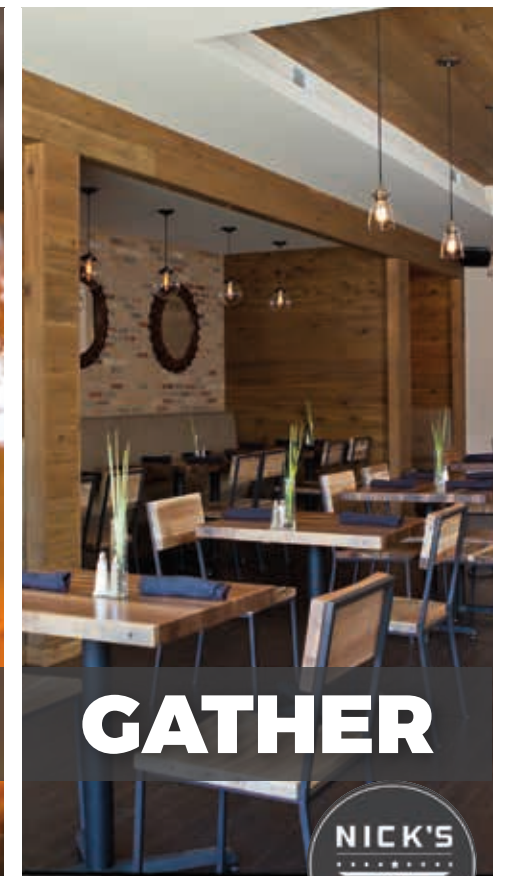

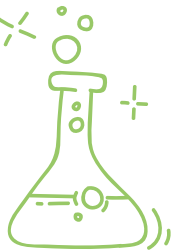

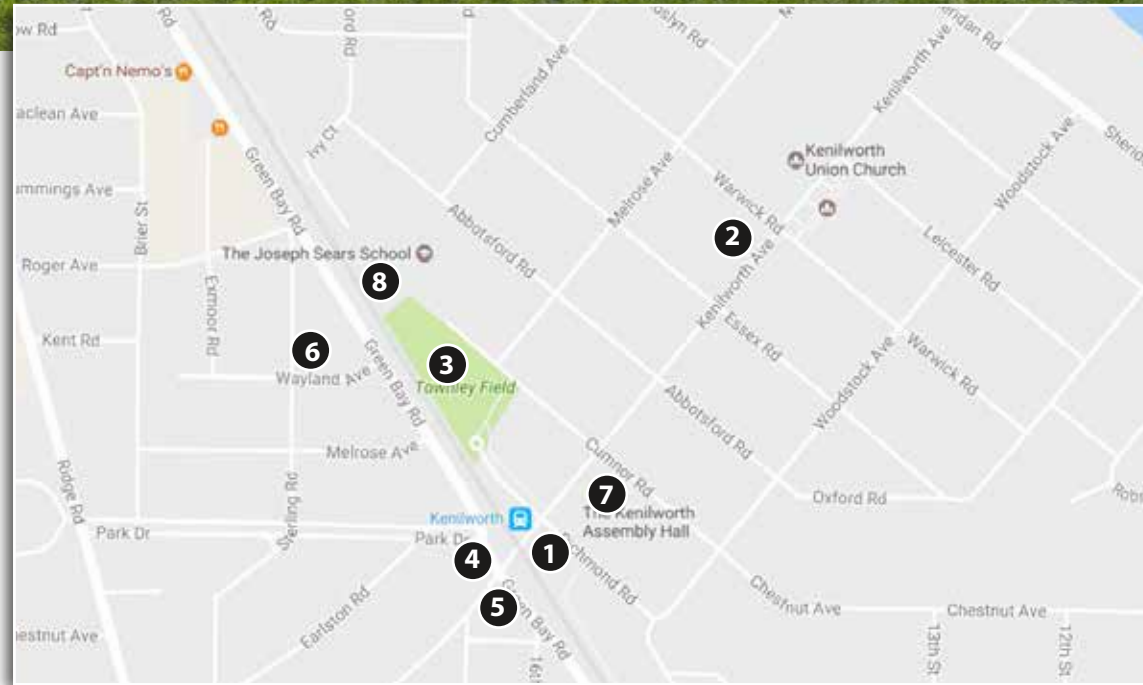

Who is a Kenilworth Resident?

Anyone living within the geographic boundaries of the Kenilworth Park District is considered a resident. Outside of the Kenilworth Park District geographic boundaries, this privilege is also extended to Kindergarten through Grade 8 students living in the geographic boundaries of Joseph Sears Public School District 38. Parents of these children are not eligible for resident fees. Kenilworth residents make financial contributions to the Kenilworth Park District through property taxes.

Cancellations, Refunds

The Kenilworth Park District reserves the right to cancel, postpone, or combine classes, or change instructors. If insufficient enrollment causes a class to be canceled, notification will be given and full tuition refunded. Withdrawals prior to the start of class receive a full refund. A prorated refund will be issued for withdrawals after classes begin. Summer Camps and Sports Leagues have separate refund policies.

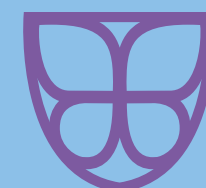
