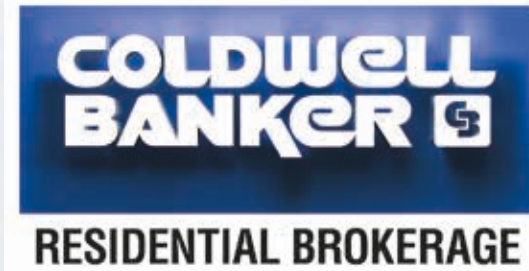

History of the KENILWORTH ASSEMBLY HALL



GEORGE MAHER AND THE KENILWORTH CLUB

Bill Hinchliff, Kenilworth history buff, recently spoke to members and friends of the Kenilworth Club. I am sharing some of his presentation on the history of the Club for those people who were not able to join us that day.



Starting in the 1890s talk had begun about having a clubhouse in the village, a building for the Kenilworth Club organization, a group

that promoted social and civic enrichment and the Neighbors of Kenilworth, a ladies' group that focused on educational programs. By 1906 or so, things began to happen. The same year Kenilworth's first park was formed on both sides of Kenilworth Avenue between Richmond and Cumnor roads. Joseph Sears, village founder, donated the southeast corner of the park for the site of an Assembly Hall. An Assembly Hall Association was created to float a bond to finance the project.

This broadened the ownership of the building to Village residents in addition to the Kenilworth Club and the Neighbors.

George Maher, a village resident, was named architect. In 1909, the great landscape architect, Jens Jensen, joined the effort and prepared a landscaping plan for a new park. His and Maher's plan of 1907 included both the South and North sides of Kenilworth Avenue and showed the park as a whole with Kenilworth Avenue bisecting it. The park is still viewed as a spacious green space with fine trees and memorial sculptures.

Both men took full advantage of the site. In Maher's case this meant setting the building well back from the street, giving it breathing room as well as integrating the building into the overall scheme of architectural embellishments (fountain, curving bench and urns.)

As we look at this old picture of the building various architectural features are seen such as the low-slung, stretched-out rectangle, a classic Prairie form as the building becomes one with the land. Maher placed an elm tree in the building's entranceway. The great old tree survived for many years, blasting right through the roof. It succumbed in the 60s.

The most spectacular of all are the marvelous art glass windows with their Growth Motif design, repeated in various sizes and forms - windows, doors and lamps, throughout the building. The Growth Motif appears in other

architectural details as well. The stem with the diamond on top (an abstract tree or flower) is seen throughout the club on furniture, and irons and originally even in the fabrics of the stage curtain. Maher called this Motif Rhythm theory, which meant tying everything together with a particular visual theme, usually a flower or plant. Recently restored, long-lost color accents now come into play most strongly with these motif designs on the exterior walls, blues, greens, browns, against the warm sandy finish of the walls.

In addition to being an architect, George Maher was a planner and eloquent writer on architecture, especially about the new Prairie Style. One of his favorite hobbies was motoring. He had the first car in Kenilworth. He was a key player in the development of Kenilworth's west side in the early 1920s, turning a 9-hole golf course into a beautiful new neighborhood of fine revivalist homes.

Little Springs

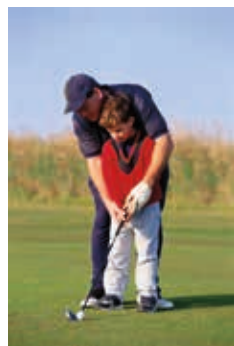

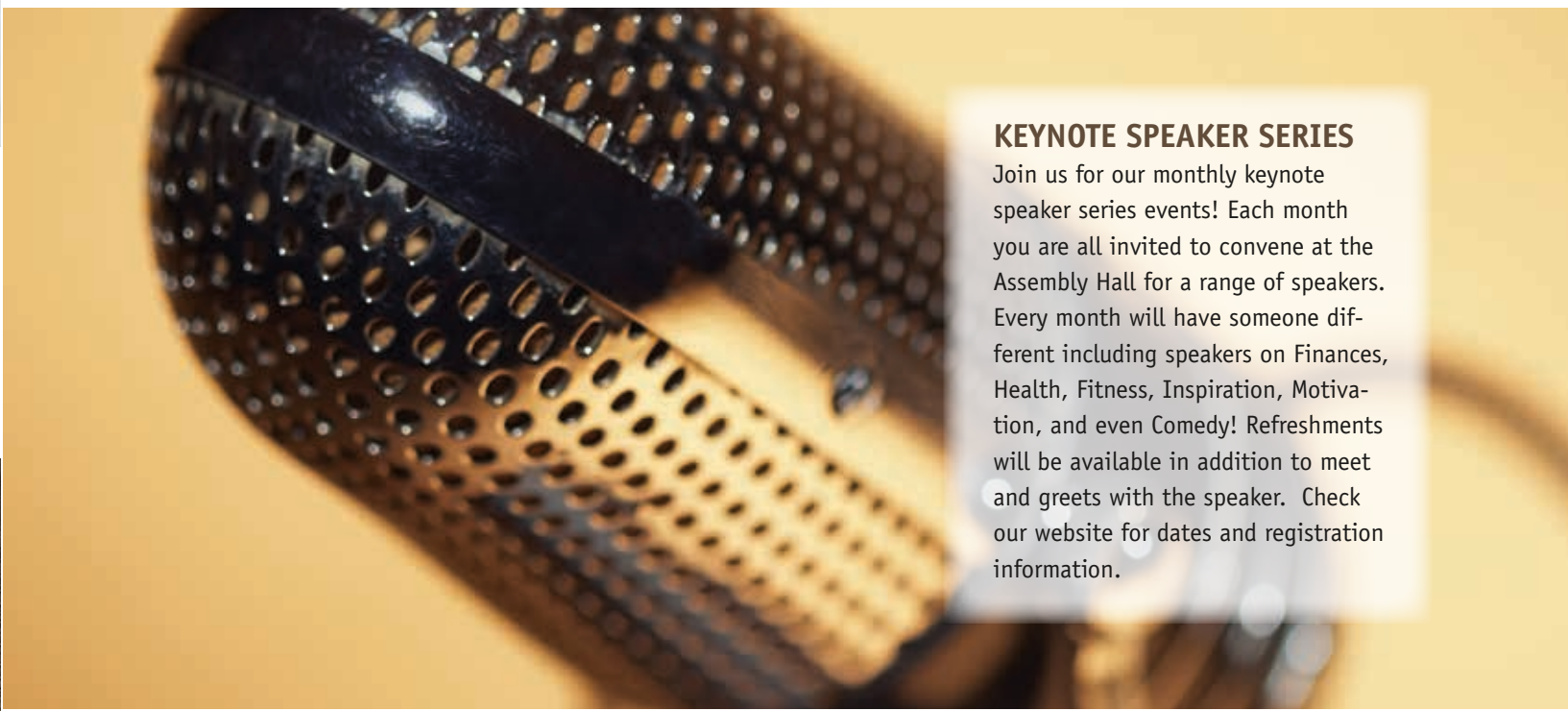

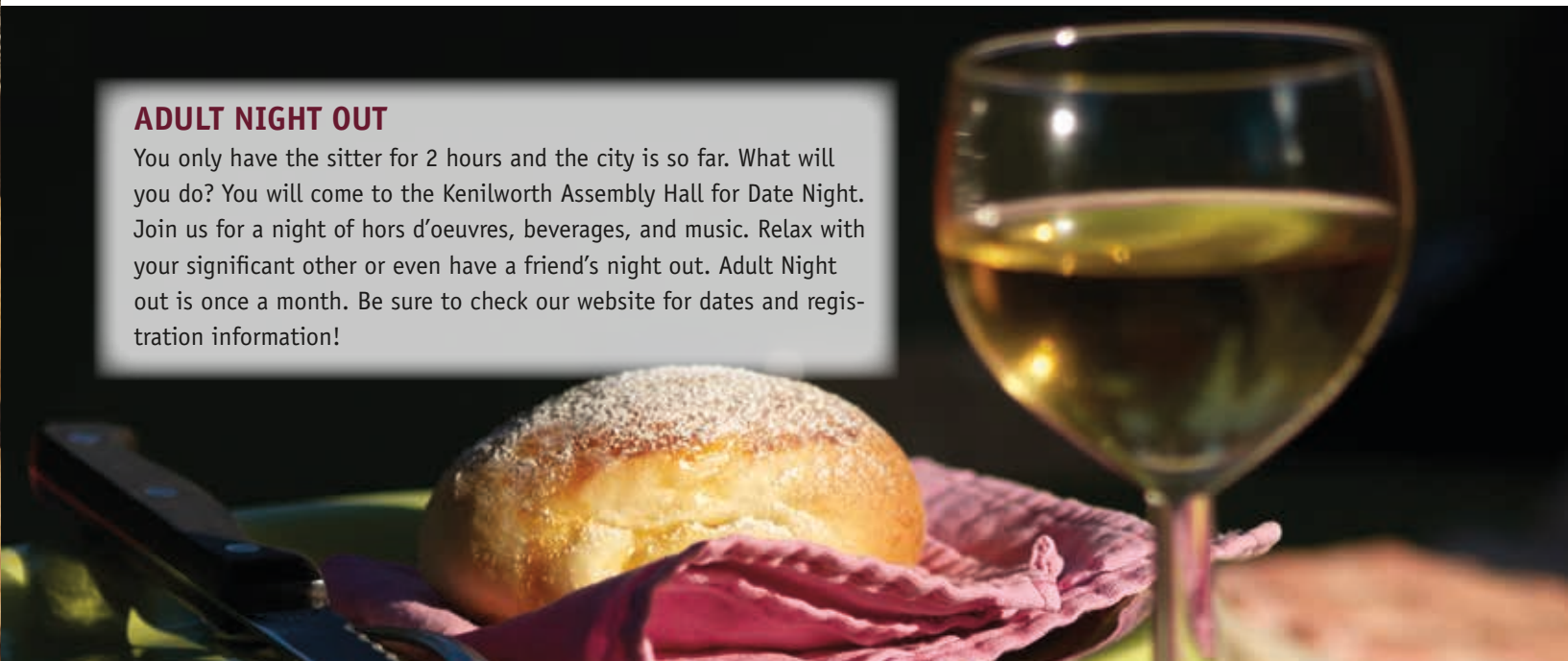
SUMMER MOVIE NIGHTS

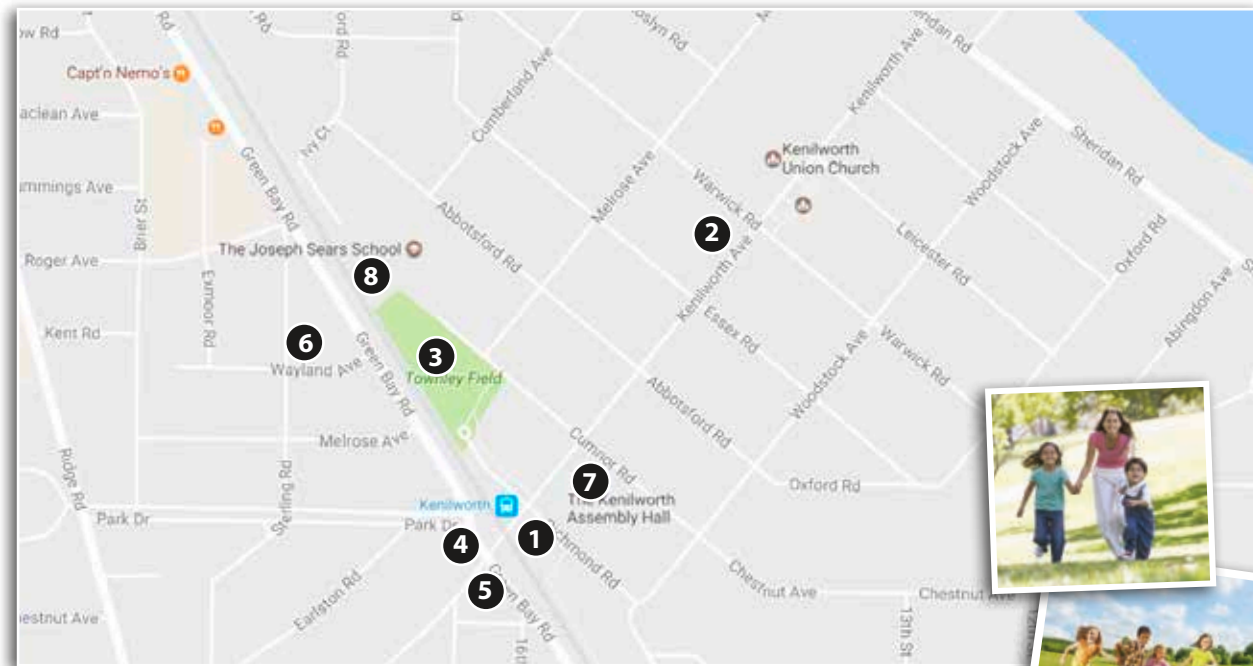


COOKING CLASS SERIES

District Policies

Who is a Kenilworth Resident?

Anyone living within the geographic boundaries of the Kenilworth Park District is considered a resident. Outside of the Kenilworth Park District geographic boundaries, this privilege is also extended to Kindergarten through Grade 8 students living in the geographic boundaries of Joseph Sears Public School District 38. Parents of these children are not eligible for resident fees. Kenilworth residents make financial contributions to the Kenilworth Park District through property taxes.

Cancellations, Refunds

If you have any questions regarding refunds, please call the Kenilworth Park District Main Office at 847-251-1691.

The Kenilworth Park District reserves the right to cancel, postpone, or combine classes, or change instructors. Insufficient enrollment may cause a class/program or event to be cancelled. If this happens, registrants will be notified and given a full refund.

- Withdrawals 5 days prior to the start date of the program/event will receive a full refund.
- Withdrawals less than 5 days prior to the start date of the program/event

will receive a refund less a 20% fee.

- Withdrawals requested for a class/program or event after it has begun will only be given in the event of an illness, injury, or relocation.
- Refund requests due to relocation must provide documentation as proof of imminent relocation.
- Refund requests due to illness or injury must provide Doctors documentation. Refunds will be prorated based on the date the medical documentation is received.
- The Kenilworth Park District will not issue refunds for classes that are canceled due to inclement weather, or other circumstances beyond the District's control. The Park District may schedule a make-up class, when possible.
- All pre-paid fitness passes are non-refundable and non-transferable.

The Kenilworth Park District does its best to process refunds in a timely manner. Refunds for check payment take approximately two weeks. A credit to your charge card takes 6-8 weeks to appear on your statement.

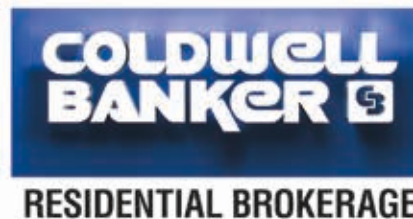

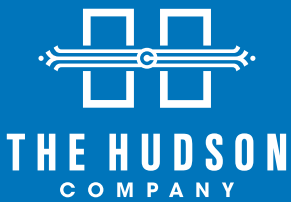
